As our nation's wars slow down, SOF personnel are leaving the military for the private sector. Over the next 10 years, an estimated 25,000 special operations personnel will be exiting the military and searching for civilian opportunities; there is an estimated current U.S. workforce of approximately 90,000 former special operators.

Currently, SOF personnel have no option for job searching that is tailored to their specific capabilities and requirements. Simultaneously, private industry is experiencing a capability gap between leadership and operational skills present in today's work force and those skills required for dominance in the current dynamic, complex, and swiftly changing environment. ExBellum's intent is to fill the current capability gap in private industry with SOF personnel separating from the military services. ExBellum conducts two lines of effort: ExBellum.com, a unique online employment website that securely connects employers and staffers with an unparalleled network of former SOF personnel; ExBellum Customized Staffing solutions, a personalized service that individually places former SOF personnel in roles based on client requirements.
